### TREE BRANCH PICKUP SCHEDULE

Please note of the following regulations:

1. Tree branches must be out in the same location as your garbage pickup by 8:00am.
2. This service does not include pickup of household items or junk.
3. Tree branches will be picked up free-of-charge ONLY when the amount is no larger than half-ton size load. Loads larger than that size will be subject to a pick-up fee of \$50 per load.
4. Branches cannot exceed 4 feet in length and 3 inches in diameter.

## BUILDING AND DEVELOPMENT

*Spring is around the corner, along with construction season!*

The Town's Zoning Bylaw and Building Bylaw work hand-in-hand to manage land use and ensure that all buildings in the municipality are safe and constructed to national standards. Development and building permits must be obtained prior to construction, alteration, renovation, change of use or occupancy, and demolition or moving of any building located in town.

Applications for development and building permits are made at the Town Office and should be submitted well in advance of the start of construction projects. Please note that all builders or contractors require a Town of Wadena business licence.

## REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION REVIEW

The Town of Wadena and RM of Lakeview are concerned about safety issues related to trucks passing through Wadena, particularly in vicinity of Wadena Elementary School and Main Street. The Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure (MHI), Town of Wadena and RM of Lakeview have agreed to work together in partnership to undertake a regional transportation review to identify potential solutions to alleviate safety concerns with the truck traffic.

This review will assess regional transportation needs, constraints, and opportunities through data collection and analysis and completion of a needs assessment. Options will be developed and communicated to both stakeholders and the public for feedback.

The Steering Committee met in January and February to collect and review data. The next meeting is scheduled in March to begin the needs assessment.
